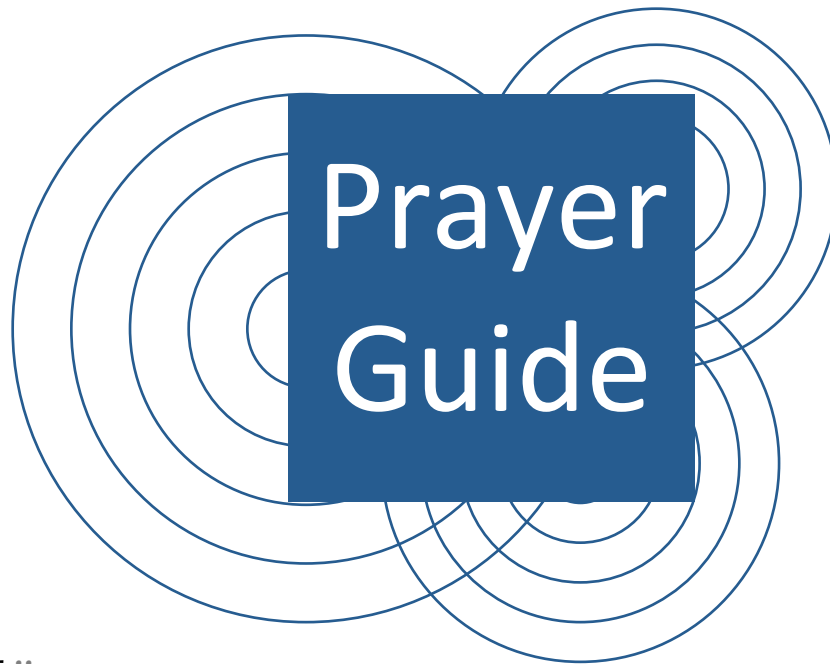


Parents, this is a guide to help you through the process of talking with your kids about purity and making a purity pledge. Here is how it works:

- Pray with your kids using the **Prayer Guide**.
- Use your Bible to look up the Scriptures together and talk about their meaning, using the **Scripture Guide**.
- Share a story or testimony from your own life.
- Read the commitments in the **Purity Pledge**, OR talk with your child to come up with your own TOGETHER, and write your own purity pledge on the paper provided. Discuss any questions your child has.
- If your child is ready, sign the **Purity Pledge** together

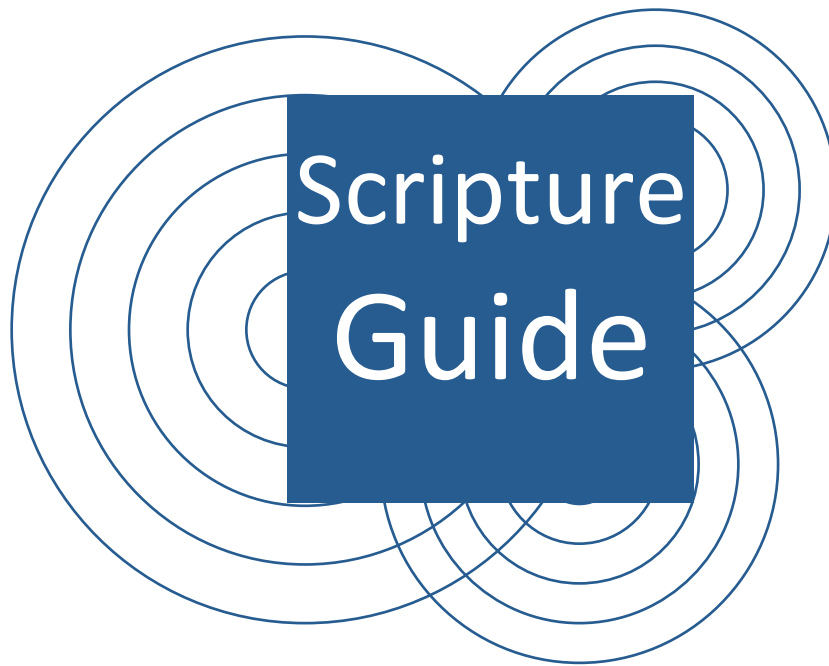


Parent ::
